You will need to provide us with proof of your identity, country of residence and nationality to open your account.

A current picture driving licence OR unexpired passport OR unexpired (old style) driving licence PLUS any of the following:-



Recent proof of state or local authority benefit (no more than 12 months old)

PLUS

A current Council Tax bill OR Bank Statement OR Credit Card/Debit Card statement (not printed from the internet) OR a Utility Bill (no more than 3 months old).

FAIRshare is a non-profit making 'community bank' for savings and loans exclusively for anyone who lives or works in the Borough of Telford & Wrekin, Broseley and Much Wenlock. Junior Accounts are also available for children and can be opened on their behalf from birth.



As soon as an adult opens a FAIRshare account they become a member as well as a shareholder in the company. Regular savings create a 'pool of money' which is used to provide low cost loans to members - from only 1% (12.68% APR) per month which is significantly less than other lenders.

What else makes us different?

Unlike high street banks and building societies we DON'T carry out any credit checks before we will let you open an account. We DON'T allow any previous CCJs - bankruptcy or insolvency - to prevent you from joining. And we DON'T charge for any of the services we provide. All we DO ask is that you pay a one-off membership fee of £5 when you open your FAIRshare Home Account and regularly save a minimum of £5 per week with us.

You can add to your savings at any time - by payroll deduction from your salary, standing order from your bank account, in person at any of our branches or by direct transfer from your pension, housing allowance or other benefit payments. You can also take out your money at any time - either in person at any of our branches, by phone or via email - whichever suits you.

Looking for an affordable loan?

Access to low cost loans is one of the major benefits of joining FAIRshare. Any adult member who is a regular saver can apply at any time. The amount you can borrow will depend on how much you can afford to repay based on your income and existing expenditure. There are no arrangement fees and your loan will be covered by FREE life insurance -at no extra cost*. Interest is calculated on the reducing balance - not the original amount of the loan.



We can also help by repaying any existing higher interest loans you may have with other lenders and reduce your monthly payments. No loan is too small and we will calculate the repayment amount and period to suit your individual circumstances. There are no hidden charges- and no penalties if you find you are able to clear your loan earlier than you expected.
